**Assistance Program for Affected Business Owners**

According to the announcement of Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation on the assistance program for people who have been impacted by the outbreak of COVID-19 dated March 12, 2020, the Ministry has requested the universities to consider decreasing venue rental fees for small business owners as well as offering additional assistance to those affected by the incident as deemed appropriate.

By virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Act, B.E. 2541 and the resolution from the Special Meeting of Sub-committee of Benefit and Property Management dated March 24, 2020, the university has hereby resolved to offer assistance to small business owners and entrepreneurs in the university who have been adversely affected by Coronavirus disease (COVID-19). Fees for commercial space management and maintenance, utilities and other outstanding fees in March and April 2020 will be reduced according to the criteria specified by the Sub-committee of Benefit and Property Management. With regard to the contractors of the university's student residence, the assistance will be arranged according to the resolution made by the University's Student Residence Management Committee.

Effective from March 1, 2020 through April 30, 2020.
