**Order of the Centre for the Administration of the Situation
due to the Outbreak of the Communicable Disease Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)**

No. 3/2563

Re : Guidelines based on Regulations Issued under Section 9
of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005)
(No. 2)

Whereas the Prime Minister, upon the approval of the Council of Ministers, declared an Emergency Situation in all areas of the Kingdom of Thailand as from 26 March B.E. 2563 (2020) to 30 April B.E. 2563 (2020), and subsequently issued the Notification on the Extension of Duration of the Declaration of an Emergency Situation in all areas of the Kingdom of Thailand (1st Extension) on 28 April B.E. 2563 (2020) taking effect from 1 May B.E. 2563 (2020) to 31 May B.E. 2563 (2020);

In order to perform tasks under the Regulations issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005), under the Declaration of an Emergency Situation and the extension of its duration, and under the Order of the Prime Minister No. 5/2563 on the Establishment of a Special Task Force to Perform Duties in Accordance with the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005), issued on 25 March B.E. 2563 (2020), and its amendments, in an efficient manner, by virtue of Clause 4 (2) of the Order of the Prime Minister No. 4/2563 on the Appointment of Supervisors, Chief Officials and Competent Officials Responsible for Remediating the Emergency Situation, issued on 25 March B.E. 2563 (2020), and its amendments, the Prime Minister, in the capacity of the Director of the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration, hereby orders Chief Officials responsible for remediating the emergency situation and competent officials to strictly carry out functions in accordance with the disease prevention measures annexed to this Order.

This Order shall come into effect as from 17 May B.E. 2563 (2020) until otherwise ordered.

Main Control Measures mean implementing measures under Clause 11 of the Regulation Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 1).

Supplementary Measures are measures in addition to Main Control Measures which require cooperation from business operators and activity organisers, including customers and participants, in order to make measures preventing and controlling the spread of the COVID-19 disease more efficient.

Operations manual serves as guidelines and conditions for carrying out business operations and the organisation of activities in each area, in order to maintain prevention measures for the spread of the COVID-19 disease in a continuous manner, and for people to be able to live safely from the spread of COVID-19 disease in accordance with the Sufficiency Economy Philosophy.

Businesses or Activities determined under the Order of the Centre for the Administration of the Situation due to the Outbreak of the Communicable Disease Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) No. 2/2563 on the Guidelines based on Regulations Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) shall consider introducing additional measures utilising the mobile phone application as prescribed by the government or apply control measures by recording data and reporting instead.
