

Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and surveillance of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) No.14 Extension of Temporary closure of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi

To comply with Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No.9), dated May 29, 2020 and to allow smooth and efficient operation and compliance with the additional measure of the government to prevent the crisis of COVID-19 outbreak, by virtue of Section 24 and 27 of the University ACT B.E. 2541, the university has thus issued this announcement. The details are as follows:

- 1. The Announcement of KMUTT on the measure and surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 12 regarding the extension of temporary closure shall remain effective.
- 2. An amendment is made to Clause 2 of the KMUTT Announcement on the Measure and surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 12 regarding the extension of temporary closure of KMUTT, i.e. the closure of every area of KMUTT will be extended to June 30, 2020.
- 3. The restriction of the buildings of all educational areas is now being relaxed, and they are allowed for meetings, examination management, recruitment, short-term trainings or any other similar purposes for up to fifteen days.
- 4. Those who will be assigned to return to work on-campus during this period on alternate schedule are at the discretion of Vice President, Assistant to the President, Dean, Director of the Office/Institute, Head of Department, and the Office Director or equivalent. The ratio of the employees working oncampus to working from home is not higher than 40:60.
- 5. Any department responsible for organizing the activities according to Clause 3 and 4 is required to follow the order of Center for the Administration of the Situation due to the Outbreak of the Communicable Disease Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) No. 4/2020 regarding the regulations issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No.3), as well as other related practices and guidelines.

6. If there is any problem or issue arising from this announcement, Senior Vice President for Administrative Affairs who is in charge of Operations and Emergency Assistance Center of KMUTT is tasked with deliberating and executing any action deemed appropriate and reporting the President accordingly.

Effective from June 1, 2020 onwards until further notice.
