

## Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 31

## Extension of Temporary Closure of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi

With reference to the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT) on the Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 27, dated April 9, 2021, No. 29, dated April 29, 2021 and No. 30, dated May 7, 2021 regarding the temporary closure of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, the University has observed the situation and recognized that the outbreak situation in Bangkok and the greater Bangkok area has gradually escalated resulting in a consistent rise in the number of COVID-19 infections.

In response to the additional preventive measures prescribed by the government authorities and to ensure smooth and effective operation of the university during the crisis, by the virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi ACT B.E.2541, the University thus issued this Announcement. The details are as follows:

- 1. The Announcement of KMUTT on the Measure and Surveillance of COVID-19 Outbreak No. 27, No. 28 and No. 29 shall remain effective.
  - 2. The temporary closure of every area of the University shall be extended to June 30, 2021.

Effective from June 1, 2021 until further notice.
