

## Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 32 Extension of Temporary Closure of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi

To comply with the regulation issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (No. 25) announced in the Royal Gazette on June 26, 2021 and to ensure smooth and effective operation of the University in line with the preventive measures prescribed by the government authorities during the COVID-19 crisis, by the virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi ACT B.E.2541, the University thus issued this Announcement. The details are as follows:

1. The Announcement of KMUTT on the Measure and Surveillance of COVID-19 Outbreak No. 27, No. 28 and No. 29 shall remain effective.

2. The temporary closure of every area of the University shall be extended to July 31, 2021. Should there be any reason or urgent need to come to the University, students and staff must strictly comply with the procedure and preventive measures announced by the University.

3. If there shall be any issues arising from this announcement, the Senior Vice President for Administrative Affairs as Director of COVID-19 Emergency Operation and Assistance Center is tasked with deliberating and executing any action deemed appropriate and reporting to the President accordingly.

Effective from July 1, 2021 until further notice.
