

Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 34

Temporary closure of all of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi campuses in Bangkok

With reference to the Order of the Centre for the Administration of the Situation due to the Outbreak of the Communicable Disease Coronavirus (COVID-19) No.9/2564 based on Regulations issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005), regarding New COVID-19 Zoning Areas including Maximum and Strict Controlled Area, Maximum Controlled Area, Controlled Area and High Surveillance Area. In response to additional measures of the government, by the virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of the King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi ACT B.E.2541, the University announces temporary closure and to allow smooth and effective operations of the university, details are as follows.

- 1. All of KMUTT campuses located in Bangkok Metropolitan Area are temporarily closed from July 12, 2021, until further notice.
- 2.All students and staff are restricted to enter the campus, whereas all classes are to be conducted online and all staff are requested to Work from Home with the exception for those out of necessity including officers in charge of security; university infrastructure and information technology; those who impose legal obligations or those obligated to projects under agreement or contract designating required duration/deadline; those overseeing students or staff residing inside the university's dormitory; those engaging in COVID-19 projects or COVID-19 related projects; and those assigned by supervisors to complete important or urgent work as the interruption would jeopardize the government work. Thus, personnel entering the university must strictly comply

with the COVID-19 preventive measures and recommendations of the government and the University for utmost safety of themselves and the public.

- 3. The University will only allow students, staff or visitors besides those mentioned in Clause 2 of this announcement to enter the university for purposes of performing duties related to COVID-19 vaccination or to receive COVID-19 vaccines.
- 4. Apart from those mentioned above, the Senior Vice President for Administrative Affairs as Director of COVID-19 Emergency Operation and Assistance Center shall give permission to those having to enter the university and report to the President accordingly.
