

Notice of

King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 59 on July 14, 2021

On July 14, 2021, the University was reported 3 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Chemistry, Faculty of Science **(the 76th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in the care of the relevant government agencies and is waiting to be transferred to hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on June 29, 2021 in the afternoon. She wore a facemask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. Except for that day, she hadn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hadn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a male master's student from the Department of Food Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 77th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in the care of the relevant government agencies and is waiting to be transferred to hospital for treatment. The student hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students and staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male visiting researcher of KMUTT's research project **(the 78th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a government hospital for treatment. The researcher entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) for conducting his research project at the Department of Mechanical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering from July 7 to 9, 2021. He strictly complied with the University's preventive measures by wearing a face mask all the time, washing hands frequently, and keeping distance from the others while working in the laboratory. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected researcher might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
