King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 56 on July 11, 2021

On July 10, 2021, the University was reported 3 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Electrical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 70th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a government hospital for treatment. The student hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students and staff since June. However, the student met a group of his friends and did activities together outside the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in late June. Currently, all of his friends are undergoing a 14-day quarantine to monitor their symptoms. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Joint Management Program, Media Arts and Media Technology, School of Architecture and Design **(the 71st case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a government hospital for treatment. The student hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus and Bang Khun Thian Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students and staff since June. However, the student met a group of her friends and did activities together outside the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in late June. Currently, all of her friends are undergoing a 14-day quarantine to monitor their symptoms. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Microbiology, Faculty of Science **(the 72nd case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in the care of the relevant government agencies and is waiting to be transferred to hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on June 29, 2021 in the afternoon. She wore a facemask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. Except for that day, she hadn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hadn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
