The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 77 on August 1, 2021

On August 1, 2021, the University was reported 7 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follow

The first case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Production Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology **(the 178th case of KMUTT)**. The student has already registered for Home Isolation Program, and is currently waiting for further response from the government agencies. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Tool and Materials Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 179th case of KMUTT)**. The student has already registered for Home Isolation Program, and is currently waiting for further response from the government agencies. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Physics, Faculty of Science **(the 180th case of KMUTT)**. The student has already registered for Home Isolation Program, and is currently waiting for further response from the government agencies. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fourth case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Chemical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 181st case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a government hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on June 29, 2021 in the morning. He wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. Except for that day, he hadn't visited the University and hadn't done any activities with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fifth case is a female staff member of the Office of the President **(the 182nd case of KMUTT)**. The staff has already registered for Home Isolation Program. The staff reported that she entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) on the following dates: July 19, July 21 and July 22, 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The sixth case is a male staff member of the Department of Mechanical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 183rd case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The staff reported that he entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) on July 27, 2021. He wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The seventh case is a female staff member of the Office of the President **(the 184th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a government hospital for treatment. The staff reported that she entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) on July 22, 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
