

Notice of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi: The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 82 on August 6, 2021

On August 6, 2021, the University was reported 5 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male master's student from the Faculty of Science (the 222nd case of KMUTT). Currently, he is receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program) under the care of a private hospital. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on June 14, 2021. He wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. Except for that day, he hadn't visited the University and hadn't done any activities with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female staff member of the Center of Energy Environment Safety and Health (the 223rd case of KMUTT). She has already contacted the relevant government agencies, and is currently waiting for further response regarding her treatment program. The staff reported that she entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) on the following dates: July 23 and July 26, 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The investigation revealed 5 staff members who are considered as a risk group. The University has given order the said staff members to undergo self-quarantine and work from home for 14 days.

The third case is a male staff member of the Center of Energy Environment Safety and Health (the 224th case of KMUTT). He has already contacted the relevant government agencies, and is currently waiting for further response regarding his treatment program. The staff reported that he entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) on the following dates: July 23 and July 26, 2021. He wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The investigation revealed 5 staff members who are considered as a risk group. The University has given order the said staff members to undergo self-quarantine and work from home for 14 days.

The fourth case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Environmental Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 225th case of KMUTT). Currently, he is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on June 28, 2021. He wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. Except for that day, he hadn't visited the University and hadn't done any activities with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fifth case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Environmental Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 226th case of KMUTT). Currently, she is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on June 14, 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. Except for that day, she hadn't visited the University and hadn't done any activities with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
