## King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi: The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 85 on August 9, 2021

On August 9, 2021, the University was reported 12 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Electrical Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology (the 247<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, he is receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female master's student from the School of Bioresources and Technology (the 248<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, she is receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Printing and Packaging Technology, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology (the 249<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). He is currently waiting to be transferred to a government hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on June 21, 2021. He wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. Except for that day, he hadn't visited the University and hadn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fourth case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Tool and Materials Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 250<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, she is receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fifth case is a male master's student from the School of Liberal Arts (the 251<sup>st</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, he is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The sixth case is a male undergraduate student from the Information Technology Program, School of Information Technology (the 252<sup>nd</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, he is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on June 28, 2021. He wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. Except for that day, he hadn't visited the University and hadn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The seventh case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Microbiology, Faculty of Science (the 253<sup>rd</sup> case of KMUTT). He is currently waiting to be transferred to a government hospital for treatment. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The eighth case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Educational Communications and Technology, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology (the 254<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, she is in a government hospital for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The ninth case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Educational Communications and Technology, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology (the 255<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, she is receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The tenth case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Mathematics, Faculty of Science (the 256<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, she is receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since June. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The eleventh case is a female cleaning staff who works on the mezzanine floor of the King Mongkut's 190<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Memorial Building (the 257<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, she is receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The last day that she was at work is August 3, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The twelfth case is a female cleaning staff who works on the 1st floor of the Student Affairs Office (the 258<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT). Currently, she is receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The last day that she was at work is August 2, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
