

Notice of

King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 111 on September 5, 2021

On September 5, 2021, the University was reported 2 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Microbiology, Faculty of Science **(the 405th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a hospital for treatment. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female cleaning staff who works on the 1st floor of the Classroom Building 4, KMUTT Bangmod Campus **(the 406th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment. The last day that she was at work is August 17, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
