

Notice of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi: The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 114 on September 8, 2021

On September 8, 2021, the University was reported 3 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Computer Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 412th case of KMUTT). Currently, she is in a hospitel for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female cleaning staff who works in the KMUTT Library Building, KMUTT Bangmod Campus (the 413th case of KMUTT). Currently, she is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The last day that she was at work is September 2, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male security guard working at the KMUTT Computer Center, KMUTT Bangmod Campus (the 414th case of KMUTT). Currently, he is in a government hospital for treatment. The last day that he was at work is September 5, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
