

Notice of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi: The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 115 on September 9, 2021

On September 9, 2021, the University was reported 5 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female master's student from the Department of Food Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 415th case of KMUTT). Currently, the student is in a government hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) on September 2, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Control System and Instrumentation Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 416th case of KMUTT). Currently, he is in a hospitel for treatment. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Control System and Instrumentation Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 417th case of KMUTT). Currently, he is in a hospitel for treatment. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control. The fourth case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Mechanical Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology (the 418th case of KMUTT). Currently, he is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fifth case is a male security guard working in the 14-floor Car Parking Building, KMUTT Bangmod Campus (the 419th case of KMUTT). Currently, he is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The last day that he was at work is September 5, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
