King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi: The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 119 on September 14, 2021

On September 14, 2021, the University was reported 3 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Electronic and Telecommunication Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 428th case of KMUTT). Currently, he is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Mathematics, Faculty of Science (the 429th case of KMUTT). The student reported that she has fully recovered from COVID-19 after receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male undergraduate student from the Media Technology Program, School of Architecture and Design (the 430th case of KMUTT). The student reported that he has fully recovered from COVID-19 after receiving treatment in a hospitel. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus and KMUTT Bang Khun Thain Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
