King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 117 on September 12, 2021

On September 12, 2021, the University was reported 5 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male master's student from the Department of Physics, Faculty of Science (**the 422nd case of KMUTT**). The student reported that he has fully recovered from COVID-19 after receiving treatment in a hospital. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Applied Computer Science-Multimedia Program, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology (**the 423rd case of KMUTT**). The student reported that she has fully recovered from COVID-19 after receiving medical treatment at home (Home Isolation Program). The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male security guard working in the 14-floor Car Parking Building, KMUTT Bangmod Campus (**the 424th case of KMUTT**). He has already contacted the hospital, and is currently waiting for further response regarding his treatment program. The last day that he was at work is September 9, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fourth case is a female cleaning staff who works on the 9th floor of the Classroom Building 4, KMUTT Bangmod Campus **(the 425th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The last day that she was at work is September 7, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fifth case is a male cleaning staff who works in the Heliconia House Building, KMUTT Bangmod Campus **(the 426th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The last day that he was at work is September 8, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
