## King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

### The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

#### No. 145 on October 20, 2021

On October 20, 2021, the University was reported 3 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male PhD. student from the School of Energy, Environment, and Materials (**the 488<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT**). Currently, he is in a hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bang Khun Thian Campus) in early September 2021. He wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. In addition, the student reported that he also visited KMUTT Bangmod Campus last week to conduct his research project at the laboratory of the School of Energy, Environment, and Materials. Accordingly, his classmates are considered as a risk group; thus, they are currently undergoing self-quarantine for 14 days to monitor their symptoms.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Applied Computer Science-Multimedia Program, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology (**the 489<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT**). Currently, she is in a private hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in early September 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Chemistry, Faculty of Science (**the 490<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT**). Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in early September 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
