The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 158 on November 17, 2021

On November 17, 2021, the University was reported 2 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female undergraduate student from the School of Information Technology **(the 513th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since October. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Joint Management Program, Media Arts and Media Technology, School of Architecture and Design **(the 514th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since October. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
