King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi: The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 137 on October 7, 2021

On October 7, 2021, the University was reported that a female master's student from the School of Information Technology (the 468th case of KMUTT) tested positive for COVID-19. Currently, she is in a private hospital for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since August. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
