



# Notice of

## King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

### The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

#### No. 133 on October 3, 2021

On October 3, 2021, the University was reported 2 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female undergraduate student from the Joint Management Program, Media Arts and Media Technology, School of Architecture and Design **(the 461<sup>st</sup> case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a private hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on September 2, 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Civil Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology **(the 462<sup>nd</sup> case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a government hospital for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since July. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
