King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi: The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 146 on October 21, 2021

On October 21, 2021, the University was reported 2 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Microbiology, Faculty of Science (the 491st case of KMUTT). Currently, she is in a government hospital for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since September. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Mechanical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 492nd case of KMUTT). The student reported that he has fully recovered from COVID-19 after receiving treatment in a hospitel. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since September. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
