King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 148 on October 26, 2021

On October 26, 2021, the University was reported 5 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Chemical, Faculty of Science **(the 496th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a government hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in early September 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Computer Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 497th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a private hospital for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since September. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a female master's student from the Department of Mechanical Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology **(the 498th case of KMUTT)**. The student reported that she has fully recovered from COVID-19 after receiving treatment in a hospital. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since September. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fourth case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Electronic and Telecommunication Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 499th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in early September 2021. She wore a face mask all the time and wasn't in close contact with other students or staff. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fifth case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Mathematics, Faculty of Science **(the 500th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment.
