King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 155 on November 9, 2021

On November 9, 2021, the University was reported that a female undergraduate student from the Joint Management Program, Media Arts and Media Technology, School of Architecture and Design (**the 510th case of KMUTT**) tested positive for COVID-19. The student reported that he has fully recovered from COVID-19 after being hospitalized for treatment in the hospital. The student hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since October. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
