

Notice of

King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 169 on December 26, 2021

On December 26, 2021, the University was reported 2 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female staff member of staff member of KX Building (the Unit under supervision of the University) **(the 533rd case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a private hospital for treatment. The staff entered the University premises (KX Building) on December 20, 2021. She kept physical distancing and wore a face mask all the time while visiting KX Building on the mentioned dates. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a male master's student from the School of Information Technology **(the 534th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a hospital for treatment. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since November. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
