



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on Grants to Assist Students with Education and Tuition Fees Payment for Semester 2/2564 (B.E.) During the COVID-19 Pandemic

The situation of COVID-19 outbreak since the beginning of 2020 until the present time has globally affected the economy and society including those in Thailand. King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi is concerned about students and has provided financial assistance and other assistance to students affected by the COVID-19 outbreak since the special semester of 2019, semesters 1 and 2 of 2020 and semester 1 of 2021.


By virtue of the University Council resolution no. 262 on June 2, 2021, the University extends the assistance and relief to the students affected by the COVID-19 under the approved budget framework until the situation improves. The University thus announces the grants to assist students with education and tuition fees payment, Semester 2/2564 (B.E.) as follows:

1. Provide grants to help students pay the academic and tuition fees for 10%. The grants cover special project fees, tuition fees, credit fees and thesis fees, and are provided to students at all levels, years, and programs for the semester 2/2564 (B.E.).
2. The grants are for students who register for the semester 2/2564 within the normal registration period, excluding the students who register to maintain student status.
3. Students who want to receive the grant must confirm their right in the system before payment. The system will deduct the amount of grant from the full payment.
4. The University extends the period for registration payment of the semester 2/2564 from the previous date of 31 January 2022 to 14 February 2022.

5. In case students have already paid their fees as mentioned in no.1 before the issue of this Announcement, the University will return the refund within the date specified by the University.

In case students have financial hardship and cannot make the payment within the period specified by the University, they should contact the Student Financial Aid Unit to request for payment extension or seek for other assistance from other available funds or grants.
