## King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

### The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

### No. 172 on December 30, 2021

On December 30, 2021, the University was reported that a female staff member of the Faculty of Engineering (**the 539<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT**) tested positive for COVID-19. Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment. The staff entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in December 2021. She kept physical distancing and wore a face mask all the time while visiting the university premises. The investigation revealed that there was a risk group. Thus, the University has given order to the staff members who were considered as the risk group to work from their residence for 14 days and to conduct the ATK tests.
