## King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

### The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

#### No. 173 on January 2, 2022

On January 2, 2022, the University was reported 3 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Civil Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology **(the 540<sup>th</sup> case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) on December 24, 2021 to attend a hands-on class at the Classroom Building 3 and met his friends off-campus. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Civil Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology **(the 541<sup>st</sup> case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment. The student visited KMUTT Bangmod Campus only on December 27, 2021 and met her friends off-campus. Except for that day, the student hadn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus). The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Civil Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology **(the 542<sup>nd</sup> case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a hospital for treatment. The student entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) only on December 27, 2021 and met his friends off-campus. Except for that day, the student hadn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus).
