

Notice of

King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi: The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak No. 174 on January 3, 2022

On January 3, 2022, the University was reported 2 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Civil Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology (the 543rd case of KMUTT). Currently, she is in a hospitel for treatment. The student visited KMUTT Bangmod Campus only on December 27, 2021 and met her friends off-campus. Except for that day, the student hadn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus). The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female staff member of the Department of Chemical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering (the 544th case of KMUTT). Currently, she is in a private hospital for treatment. The staff entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) on December 27–28, 2021. She kept physical distancing and wore a face mask all the time while visiting the university premises. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
