King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi:

The surveillance of COVID-19 outbreak

No. 177 on January 6, 20221

On January 6, 2022, the University was reported 11 COVID-19 confirmed cases as follows:

The first case is a male staff member of the Institute of Field Robotics **(the 549th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a private hospital for treatment. The staff entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in December. He kept physical distancing and wore a face mask all the time while visiting the university premises. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The second case is a female staff member of the School of Liberal Arts **(the 550th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a government hospital for treatment. The staff entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in December. She kept physical distancing and wore a face mask all the time while visiting the university premises. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The third case is a male staff member of the Center on Industrial Instrument Calibration **(the 551st case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a private hospital for treatment. The staff entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) in December. He kept physical distancing and wore a face mask all the time while visiting the university premises. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected staff might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fourth case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Educational Communications and Technology, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology **(the 552nd case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is in a hospital for treatment. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since December. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The fifth case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Chemical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 553rd case of KMUTT)**. The student reported that he has fully recovered from COVID-19 after being hospitalized for treatment. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since December. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The sixth case is a female undergraduate student from the Architecture Program, School of Architecture and Design **(the 554th case of KMUTT)**. She has already contacted the hospital, and is currently waiting for further response regarding her treatment program. The student reported that she met her friends to have meal and did activities together on December 31, 2021. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The seventh case is a male master's student from the Department of Civil Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 555th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a hospital for treatment. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since December. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The eighth case is a male undergraduate student from the Department of Chemical Engineering, Faculty of Engineering **(the 556th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, he is in a private hospital for treatment. The student reported that he hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since December. Currently, she is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since December. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.

The eleventh case is a female undergraduate student from the Department of Mechanical Technology Education, Faculty of Industrial Education and Technology **(the 559th case of KMUTT)**. Currently, she is undergoing the Home Isolation Program. The student reported that she hasn't entered the University premises (KMUTT Bangmod Campus) and hasn't done any activities with other students or staff since December. The related units are currently investigating to identify people whom the infected student might be in close contact with to assess the level of risk and continue to operate the relevant practices according to the measures of the Department of Disease Control.
