

Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 40

Overseas Travel of Students and Staff Members

Pursuant to the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 2 regarding the international travel of students and staff members effective from February 26, 2020 until further notice, as the situation of COVID-19 in many foreign countries tends to improve, and the National Communicable Disease Committee of Thailand is considering shifting COVID-19 to be an endemic disease, the Thai authorities have eased up various measures to be in consistent with the situation.

To allow the smooth and effective operations of the University, by virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi ACT, B.E. 2541, the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak No. 2 shall be repealed, and the overseas travel permission or approval shall be done in accordance with the existing University's regulations.

Effective from May 1, 2022.
